Provisions and Clauses

I. REQUIRED PROVISIONS AND CLAUSES FOR ALL OPEN MARKET SMALL PURCHASES

1) JP3 Provision B-1, Solicitation Provisions Incorporated by Reference (AUG 2004)

This solicitation incorporates one or more solicitation provisions by reference, with the same force and effect as if they were given in full text.
