AUTHORIZATION TO SUBMIT INTERIM VOUCHERS

Good cause shown, it is hereby certified pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, that the above-listed case is extended or complex, and payment in excess of the statutory maximum is necessary to assure fair compensation. Due to the complexity or length of anticipated proceedings, pursuant to paragraph 2.30 B of the Guidelines for the Administration of the Criminal Justice Act, the listed payee is authorized to submit interim CJA vouchers every two months in accordance with the following schedule:

Compensation earned and reimbursable expenses incurred from the first to the last calendar day of every two-month period shall be claimed on an interim voucher. Thereafter, compensation earned and costs incurred for each two-month period shall be claimed on each successive interim voucher submitted to the court. Time expended by any associate counsel or research counsel must be claimed on the same schedule. No voucher need be submitted for any interim period during which compensation and expenses total less than \$750.00.

Attached to this Authorization is an information sheet outlining general information regarding CJA Procedures. Attorneys and service providers are additionally expected to adhere to all requirements as outlined in the CJA Panel Attorney Manual, which can be found on the court's website: www.cand.uscourts.gov.
