**ORDER DIRECTING U.S. MARSHAL TO
PROVIDE NON-CUSTODIAL
TRANSPORTATION AND
SUBSISTENCE FOR DEFENDANT TO
ATTEND REQUIRED COURT HEARING**

[18 U.S.C. ¶4285]
[5 U.S.C.¶5702(a)]

On motion by defendant [NAME],by and through his/her counsel {NAME}, made pursuant to 18 U.S.C. ¶4285, the Court is satisfied, after an appropriate inquiry, that the defendant is financially unable to provide the necessary transportation to appear for a required court appearance in pending criminal proceedings, on his/her own.

In the interests of justice, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the United States marshal is directed to arrange for the defendant's means of non-custodial transportation or furnish the fare for such transportation to the Northern District of California where his/her appearance is required and to furnish the defendant with an amount of money for subsistence expenses to his/her destination, not

1 to exceed the amount authorized as a per diem allowance for travel under 5 U.S.C. section 5702(a).

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that travel for this defendant to the Northern District of
3 California shall be provided on [DATE OF TRAVEL] for defendant to timely appear on [DATE OF
4 APPEARANCE] at the [TYPE OF HEARING], before [NAME OF JUDGE], at [TIME OF
5 APPEARANCE] and return travel shall be provided on the same day as the court appearance.
