**PROCEEDINGS**

Change of Plea and Sentencing Hearing - held.

**RESULT OF HEARING**

The Court and counsels discuss the language contained in the new plea agreement. Defendant moves to withdraw his previous plea of guilty; GRANTED.

Mr. Chamberlain is sworn and examined by the Court. Defendant is advised of his rights and waives said rights. Mr. Chamberlain pleads guilty to count one and two of the Information. The Court finds the plea knowing and voluntary and the defendant competent to enter a plea of guilty and accepts the plea of guilty. The plea agreement is filed.

Mr. Chamberlain addresses the Court.

Defendant is committed to the Bureau of Prisons for a term of 30 months on count 1 and 30 months on count 2, both to run concurrently, followed by 12 years of supervised release on count 1 and 3 years supervised release on count 2, both to run concurrently. A special assessment fee of \$200 is imposed. The Court waives the fine. See Judgment for special conditions.

The government moves to dismiss the Third Superseding Indictment; GRANTED.

The government's Preliminary Motion for Forfeiture of Property is GRANTED.
