THE COURT: Good morning. I'm calling the Volkswagen And you're the sole survivor here, so why don't you identify yourself? Because the State of California is always present even though, of course, they are right across the street; right?

MR. AKERS: Yes, your Honor.

Good morning, your Honor. Nick Akers for the California Air Resources Board and the California Attorney General. joined by my colleague Judith Fiorentini telephonically.

THE COURT: Great. And I know a number of people are participating by telephone.

I was advised, and I have been advised throughout the course of this weekend, that there had been ongoing settlement discussions and the parties have jointly requested a final --I'm using the word "final" -- continuance to tomorrow at 11:00 o'clock Pacific coast time.

Let me just make a couple of observations because, of course, I have been apprised of developments as they have been ongoing.

This is a complicated matter. I believe lead counsel for the plaintiff's Steering Committee said that the devil is in the details, and it is to some extent. There are a lot of

details, a lot of moving parts, and there are a lot of parties.

We're -- you know, of course, we're talking about the

Department of Justice. We're talking about various states,

California being the principal one involved. We're talking

about the Federal Trade Commission. We're talking about many,

many parts.

And what the parties are attempting to achieve here is a global resolution; that is, one that will incorporate these various parties in various ways. And in order to do that, because the concerns are individual to the party, there has to be extraordinary coordination among the parties and there has to be resolution of a lot of issues, which look to some of us as just details, but to others the details have real significance.

Now, having described the problem, let me just say that I am optimistic that by tomorrow at 11:00 there will be a resolution. They are working very hard. The Special Master has indicated to me that they are meeting in Washington on these issues and that there will be continuing meetings today and, hopefully, by tomorrow we will have made real progress in terms of being able to report to the public as to where we are.

Let me just once again say that settlement discussions, negotiations, are by their nature, and ought to be, treated in confidence. That's been the order of the Court and it remains so.
